In middle school, flipping through comic book pages, Jeremy Dylan Cavin decided to turn his interest in art into a lifelong pursuit. Cavin’s crafts continued evolving through high school and college where he graduated with a bachelor of fine art in graphic design at the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma.

During his studies, Cavin found his passion for painting and figure drawing. Cavin has continued exploring other forms of art while pursuing his career in graphic design. In 2006, Cavin joined the army but sustained a leg injury shortly after. In this time, Cavin solidified his focus on historical portraits and pets.

Using ink and acrylic, Cavin creates historical portraits and other commissioned pieces filled with movement, designed to create a connection between the viewer and the artwork. His historical portraits have earned him several awards and placements in exhibits from the Choctaw Art Show to the Smithsonian National Museum of the American Indian.
