She works as a professional visual artist in art education, relief and monotype printmaking, painting, jewelry and photography. She also works as a writer, designer, and curator. Previously she worked as a full-time arts educator in Stillwater, Oklahoma, and now works full time as an artist.

In 2012, Kristin was recognized for the 40 Under 40 award by the National Center for American Indian Enterprise Development. Kristin received her M.S. degree with honors in Native American Leadership from Southeastern Oklahoma State University in the spring of 2020 and a Bachelor of Fine Arts from Oklahoma State University in 2009, where she graduated as a Senior of Significance. She attained her Associate of Art in education from Tulsa Community College in 2005 as an Honor's Scholar Graduate. Kristin is a graduate of Berryhill high school, class of 2003.
