Art had always been a hobby for Alan Burris up until his late 30s when he decided to take the non-traditional student approach and return to school. It was during this schooling that Burris met a man who taught him that art can be a career.

Burris has spent the last two decades teaching art at the college-level, covering a diverse range of art topics including painting, photography, drawing, watercolor and clay. Burris' current collection, involves primarily clay sculptures meant to represent the

idea of the Shaman as an image that seems to be both timeless and universal. The sculptures include the addition of bone, agate, copper, wood and local Oklahoma rocks.

Burris has been juried for multiple regional art shows and won awards at the USAO Seven-States Biennial Exhibition in Chickasha, Oklahoma; Five-State Photography Exhibition in Hays, Kansas; and the Great Plains Art Show in Durant, Oklahoma, just to name a few.
