Thompson has been painting for 10 years and has recently moved to Chicago from Lukachikai, AZ to achieve her bachelors degree from the Art Institute of Chicago. Thompson holds a masters degree in healthcare administration but her heart truly lives in the art world.

Thompson has exhibited her artwork in museums and art shows across the country; she recently finished a semi-solo exhibit in Geneva, Italy including four wooden sculptures and 12 paintings.

ATA is inspired by her Navajo culture and expresses her art through her emotions. Thompson's mission is to "decorate the world with more art" and she has been doing so since picking up her paint brush in 2010.
