Daniel Worcester is a member of the Chickasaw Nation and has been capturing works of art through a lens since receiving his first camera as a gift in 1966. Worcester's love for photography quickly grew beginning with black and white photography and transitioning to digital in 2007 when he began producing his own commercial images.

Inducted into the Chickasaw Hall of Fame in 2009, Worcester was also named Honored One at the 2013 Red Earth Festival in Oklahoma City and given the 2017 Silver Feather Award by the Chickasaw Nation. He has received many prestigious awards for his continuing work in the art of photography, bladesmithing and poetry.
