Edmond Perkins is an Oklahoma potter who helps farm his family's allotted land along the South Canadian River in Hughes County. Perkins uses clay from the Baker's Branch creek bed on his family land mixing it with mussel shells to create beautiful works of art.

Perkins' smaller pottery is fired within a pit taking about six hours to finish, while larger, more intricate items are fired inside a temperature controlled wood burning kiln taking between 20-24 hours to complete.
